

Tips for using Sullivan's Black Velvet Hair Dye.

Due to varying lengths of hair and differences in skin sensitivity, it is necessary to do a dye patch test on areas with shorter hair.

- On a 1000 pound animal use 3 to 4 kits per side for best results.
- Some experts recommend clipping the animal first then applying the dye to the hair.
- Do not apply hair conditioners to the hair for 2 days prior to dye application. This keeps the hair from becoming too oily which can lower the performance of the dye.
- Only mix enough dye for only one side at a time.
- Animal must be dry and clean. Blow dirt or dust out with blower prior to application.
- Mix Black Velvet with Kleen Sheen at a 1:1 ratio. This helps give you more liquid product to work with when applying the dye.
- Apply with a Sullivan Express Fogger or a Top Gun Spray Bottle.
- Only turn one switch on the blower when using the Express Fogger. This will slow down the application rate.
- Wear protective gloves to keep hands from being stained. Work dye into hair with gloved hands or use a Massage brush and Stimulator comb.
- Rinse out only. Do not shampoo out. Blow dry then heavily apply Revive or Mane n Tail conditioner.
- Apply EZ ALL It's Gone and Revive to white hair on legs or belly that you do not want dyed. This helps keeps overspray from sticking or staining the white hair.
